Excel Year 7 Critical and Creative Thinking Class 2024

Orara High School's aim is to provide opportunity, innovation and success to all students including offering the Excel extension class for Year 7 students.

What is the Excel Critical and Creative Thinking Class?

The Excel class curriculum is modified in breadth, depth and nature to provide a stimulating, enriched and engaging learning environment. With a focus on developing critical thinking and creative thinking skills.

High Potential students need a climate where they can take risks and make mistakes, identify and develop their own strengths, undertake challenging activities, have opportunities for creativity and student-initiated activities, and are encouraged to achieve excellence.

Students undertaking the Excel program will be challenged and supported to participate in a range of curricular activities such as excursions, workshops and cross faculty projects.

It is envisaged that students who undergo this program will develop positive attitudes to learning and advanced academic skills.

The Excel class will remain as a discrete group for Years 7 and 8.

How are students selected for the Excel Critical and Creative Thinking Program?

Entry to the program is by application, interview, testing and supporting nomination by a student's primary school.

How and when do we apply?

Complete the enclosed application form in cooperation with your primary school and return to Orara High School's office by close of business Monday, 29th May 2023.

Parents and students will be notified of interview appointment times and invitations to join the class will be mailed out to successful students.

Where the number of shortlisted students exceeds the number of places available, a reserve list will be established.

Parents/carers must confirm an offer of enrolment into the Excel Extension Program by the due date advised. Failure to do so may cancel the offer and allow the place to be made available to another student.

For enrolment into Orara High School, the following will also need to be completed:

Government Primary Schools - An Expression of Interest form will be issued by your primary school for completion and return to the primary school by the due date advised.

Non-Government Primary Schools – An Expression of Interest form is available from Orara High School's office for completion and return to Orara High School by the due date advised.

Students who are being offered a position at Orara High School will be sent An Application to Enrol in a NSW Government School, to be completed and returned by the due date advised.

What is the selection criteria used to determine class placement?

- Strong academic performance in one or more subjects
- Good literacy and numeracy skills
- Sound research skills, including library and internet skills.
- High level of self-motivation
- Positive attitudes to school and learning
- Ability to work as part of a team in learning situations.
- High levels of creativity evident in learning tasks
- Good communication skills

Important additional criteria are <u>enthusiasm</u> and <u>motivation</u> for learning, ability to work independently and ability to work cooperatively with others.

The teachers at Orara High School are committed to providing a quality teaching and learning environment. Teachers of the Excel class will provide challenges and exciting opportunities for students to expand their interests and develop their skills in all subject areas.

Applications will be considered by a panel of staff from Orara High School. Part of the application includes recommendations from Year 6 teachers and further consultation with these teachers will take place if necessary.

Applicants will be required to sit for an entrance test in the areas of literacy, numeracy, critical thinking and creative thinking.

Students will be judged on Year 6 work completed in class during Semester 1. All class placements are provisional, dependent on the student's performance.

What happens after Year 7?

The Excel class will continue into Year 8 as a discrete academic group.

Placement in the class is competitive and merit based & positions in the class are regularly reviewed.

Students will be required to reapply for placement in the Year 8 class at the end of Year 7.
